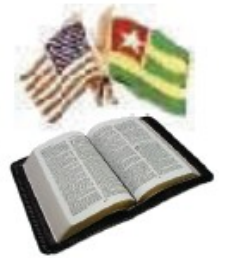

Dear Praying Partners,

We hope that this letter finds everyone well. What a joy it is to see 2009 end with all its bad news. In the year 2009 Satan used two major strategies to slow down missions around the globe.

(1) To cut off the support of the missionaries around the globe: The financial crisis lead many missionaries to leave the field, the churches are closing their doors in the US, the mission budget of many churches has gone down, the Christian people who are supporting missions have lost their jobs, or we know that 3 people die every second in the world and 180 every minute. Through this financial crisis Hell has filled up with many people who lost their lives without hearing the gospel, especially in Africa where more than 6,500 people die every day.

(2) To put fear in the heart of people: Around the globe, people are afraid of the terrorist attacks. Many people have lost their lives because of terrorism attacks. The Bible is pushed down and false religion is going up.

No matter what happens, we have to preach the Gospel. The Apostle Paul says in Rom 1:16 "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ; for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek." We stood with the Lord in the troubled year of 2009 by preaching His Word and people were saved here in Togo. On November 22nd, we dedicated the shelter we have built and 14 people were saved on that day. The fourth wife (Akouvi) of my late father was saved and she is faithful to the Church. The Lord continues to bless our ministry in spite the financial crisis we are facing. **The average of attendance is now between 70-80 adults and 40-48 children every Sunday.** In the January or February 2010, we are going to baptize the 15 new believers. In this coming year we are praying the Lord to bring in more lost souls. Keep praying for us, it is a very difficult time for everyone, not only in the US but also in Togo. We hope that the New Year, 2010, will be a blessed year for everyone; that people who lost their jobs will find another job. Remember our land need for this coming year. The price of the land is going up quickly here in Togo. It is sad to see Muslim people buying the land and building their mosques in every village here in Togo but Christian people are not able to buy a piece of land and built their church on it.
