- <sup>1</sup>Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.

# **Ephesians 6:4**

<sup>4</sup> And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

# Galatians 6:7-8

- <sup>7</sup>Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
- <sup>8</sup> For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.

#### Isaiah 1:18-20

- <sup>18</sup>Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.
- <sup>19</sup> If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land:
- <sup>20</sup> But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken *it*.

#### Isaiah 59:1-4

- <sup>1</sup>Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear:
- <sup>2</sup> But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid *his* face from you, that he will not hear.
- <sup>3</sup> For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with iniquity; your lips have spoken lies, your tongue hath muttered perverseness.
- <sup>4</sup>None calleth for justice, nor *any* pleadeth for truth: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity.

#### 1 John 3:1-3

- <sup>1</sup>Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.
- <sup>2</sup> Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know

that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

<sup>3</sup> And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

#### 2 Corinthians 3:17

<sup>17</sup> Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord *is*, there *is* liberty.

#### Psalm 25:1-5

- <sup>1</sup>Unto thee, O LORD, do I lift up my soul.
- <sup>2</sup> O my God, I trust in thee: let me not be ashamed, let not mine enemies triumph over me.
- <sup>3</sup> Yea, let none that wait on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause.
- <sup>4</sup> Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths.
- <sup>5</sup> Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou *art* the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day.

## Psalm 27:7-11

- <sup>7</sup> Hear, O LORD, when I cry with my voice: have mercy also upon me, and answer me.
- <sup>8</sup> When thou saidst, Seek ye my face; my heart said unto thee, Thy face, LORD, will I seek.
- <sup>9</sup> Hide not thy face *far* from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.
- <sup>10</sup> When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take me up.
- <sup>11</sup> Teach me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.

## Psalm 86:11

<sup>11</sup> Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in thy truth: unite my heart to fear thy name.

## Psalm 119:9-12

- <sup>9</sup> Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed *thereto* according to thy word.
- <sup>10</sup> With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments.
- <sup>11</sup> Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.
- <sup>12</sup> Blessed *art* thou, O LORD: teach me thy statutes.

- <sup>23</sup> And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;
- <sup>24</sup> And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

# Philippians 1:9-11

- <sup>9</sup> And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and *in* all judgment;
- <sup>10</sup> That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ;
- <sup>11</sup> Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.
