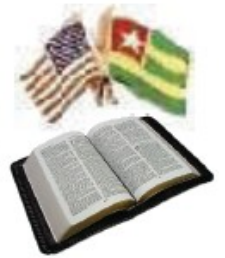

Greetings from Togo West Africa in the marvelous name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

First of all, allow us to express our gratitude to you for being our partners and supporters in the spreading of the Gospel in Togo. We are so fortunate to have so many prayer partners. We can never thank each of you enough for your time spent in intercession for our family and the work here in Togo.

God has answered your prayers. We got our container and all our stock. We thank God for that, although we paid more money than we had planned. It cost \$4,000 but we had raised only \$2,000 for this need. The Lord has supplied this need and we want to thank each one for your prayers.

#### **More Praises!**

I praise the name of the Lord because something happened on Sunday 7 September at the church called "Eglise Baptistique : la solution Adidoadin" where I was preaching. I saw my mother, my aunts, my brothers and sisters, and my cousins walking into the church. Sixteen people of my family with their kids came to hear me preach the word of God after 25 years. It was wonderful to see! My mother said to the pastor that it is the beginning. I believe that it is the beginning of the miracle of God. I say they came after 25 years, because for 25 years they refused to listen to any word from the black book.

-Praise the Lord we started the evangelism ministry on the first week of September by knocking on many doors. The Lord has opened the way for us to spread the Gospel. Many have received the message and 15 people made a profession of faith that first two weeks. For only 8 days of evangelism, the Lord gave us 15 new believers!  
- I meet two county chiefs, and both have given permission to start churches in their county.

#### **Prayer Requests**

Brethren, we are facing many problems and many challenges, but our faith is still strong. We are young missionaries and we want to do the best ministry we can before we become old. We need your help to set up everything. The cost of living here in Togo is so expensive.

-Pray for us, we need a stove for cooking and a washing machine. My wife has a hard time washing our clothes. We try to find these materials here in Togo but the price is so expensive for us.

-Pray for Samuel and Lydia, they are going to start school on September 22.

Pray for a place to worship:

We found a place to rent, but we do not have the money to build the shelter for worship services. The total cost will be \$6,725. We just need 40 churches with \$169 to meet this need.

Please, pray for us that God will supply quickly the money to build the shelter for worship.

We have a need! May the Lord answer our prayers!
