

Dear Praying Partners,

First of all, brothers and sisters let me tell you that the Lord is good and He is good all the time! It is wonderful to see the way God protects us. In the Psalm 121: 8 we read, "The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore." This is a big promise we have from God in this verse. God saved my life in January when I was involved in a bad road accident. I was not injured at all, but my car was heavily damaged. This is the only transportation we have, but I was so happy that the Lord saved my life. Keep praying that I can find the money to repair it quickly. Without a car you cannot properly do the mission work here in Togo. With this car I used to bring more people to the church every Sunday. A few weeks after this accident, my wife gave birth to a baby boy that I named Joel Mawuko which means God is mighty. This accident was not a normal accident but God is able to keep me alive in order to continue preaching the true word. They want to take my life but they will always fail. By the way, the ministry is growing because lost souls are being saved. The last past two months, were a blessing months because the average of the attendance on every Sunday was 85 to 95 adults. For the first time the attendance of children reached at 57.

Here is the statistics of the average attendance of all church services.

Program	Average Attendance
Sunday School Adult Service	35-40 people
Sunday School Children Service	48-57 people
Sunday Morning Worship Service	85-95 (48 women, 37 men)
Mid-Week Service (Prayer Meeting)	Most of the time we have 30 people

We also have a Baptism class which is held on 3:00 to 5:00 P.M. and the Ladies class that is held twice each month at 3:00 to 5:00 P.M. (the first Sunday and the last Sunday). The Sunday Evening Service has not started because we do not have electric power.

All my Sunday Morning sermons are broadcast on the Radio Station FM 89.1 (Radio la grace) every Saturday morning at 7: 00 A.M

Financial needs:

1. Repair the car.
2. Brothers and Sisters, we still need your help obtaining one table mixer and two new speakers.
3. **Urgent need:** we need just \$600 to put the doors on the shelter we have built. Without doors, thieves can steal the church property, such as the chairs, benches etc...
4. Also, we still need \$8,285. No church owned land means no mission. Thank you so much to all who have helped with this so far!
