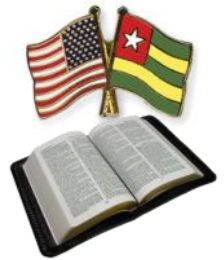

Dear Pastor and Friends,

I am very thankful to God for each of you for faithful prayers and financial support. Brothers and sisters, these past two months were a blessing to us because more souls were saved. Although our society is full of false worship and idolatry, the Holy Spirit is using our preaching and our weekly soul winning service to convince a people to give their life to the Lord. I see the need of Togolese people, hungry to hear the true gospel but there are few laborers. I made several survey trips to see many villages that need the gospel but I cannot be everywhere. I was so burdened to see many villages without a church, no healthy water, no dug well, no clinic etc.... I try to do my best, preach the gospel that people must be saved. Our efforts were not in vain for both mission works we have. We put a lot effort in weekly soul winning and the crusade and we are seeing results. Easter Sunday our church was full with 52 men, 74 women and 169 children. After the preaching seven precious souls were saved and are faithfully coming to our church. Brothers and sisters keep praying for us, my desire is to reach between 250 and 300 in attendance every Sunday by the end of this year 2012.

Here a few request prayers I need that the Lord would provide quickly:

1. We need at least \$2,500 to organize a youth camp meeting this year on July 22. Right now we do not have any sponsor to help us to do it. These past two years we have seen many teenagers make a profession of faith. This year we project to have 400 teenagers but we have no money.
2. We need two motos for my co-workers in order to take the gospel to the remote village where a van cannot go. Some of my co-workers have to walk long distances to come to the church. A moto will a big help to us to reach a remote village in crusade time. If you can help us that would good. One moto cost only \$1,000 with all taxes.
3. Keep praying for the work at Korbongou; Brother Emile is doing a wonderful job to reach a Muslim population. Every Sunday the attendance is now 58 with children. We are working hard to finish the church building. Right now the concrete blocks we need are done. We are faced many challenges; there is not water, we had to dig a well for them. Finding the cement is a major problem for us, and costs almost double the regular price. We have to travel many km before find a few bags. That situation leads us to go slowly but people are happy; very soon they will have their own church building.
