

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Agbodo family greets you from Togo in the Lord's precious Name. We want to take this time to express from the bottom of our hearts our gratitude for your faithful prayers and financial support for the year 2012. Without you we could not have made it through the many challenges we have faced. We cannot say that we were successful with 100% with our 2012 goals but I can say we were close for most of our goals:

We planned for 2012 to reach the attendance with all children 230 to 250. By the grace of God we had 220 to 230 in attendance every Sunday morning. We planned to have a choir by the end of year 2012, and we have of choir that started singing in December 2012 (the number is 12 people). We planned to train 10 new believers to be monitors of children classes. We finished the year 2012 by training 12 new believers to be children monitors. Some areas did not turn out as well as I wish. I pushed my people hard to go out and knock the doors in order to bring the lost souls to the Lord but only 25% of these new believers loved to go out and lead others to the Lord. Much work needs to be done in this area.

We planned to finish the building of the new church in northern of our country. We made it. Atwood Baptist church in Alabama gave us \$9,000 to do it. We bought the land and we built the church. We just need only to raise \$5,000 in order to put the roof on the top. This church has a worship place, pastor's office and storage.

***My first step for 2013 is to start the building process in our home church in the south by raising \$60,000. If God gives me 60 churches with only \$1,000 we can built that church to hold 500 to 700 people.** I believe when this church would be self-supporting, it would be a home of more church planting ministries. I have a vision and God gave me a good team but what I need is more doors open in 2013 for me. Right now I have 5 men that worked with me in full time like me to fulfill this vision, plan more Baptist churches. Remember by supporting us, we support more people. Our personal needs come second after the ministry's needs. For me God's work comes in the first place. **If you can help, that would keep me on the field until the end of 2014 or beginning 2015 before you see my face again.**

* We still need two motorbikes for the ministry here (\$2,000 total). It is a very high priority for us.

* We plan if God will to open a new field in the middle of 2013 in suburb of Lome (Togo).

* I would not finish wishing from God to you that above all things that you may prosper and be in health, even as your soul may prosper in 2013.

Brothers and sisters, we do appreciate the time you put aside to read our newsletters and pray for us. Your financial support is highly valued. We have never been able enough to express our gratitude.
