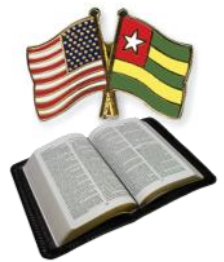

Dear Pastor and Friends ,

I am very thankful to God for each of you for faithful prayers and financial support. Brothers and sisters we start this New Year 2015 with new goals to reach more souls for the Lord. These past two months were such a blessing to us because more souls were saved. Souls are saved in the north and the south through our ministries. We are preparing to baptize 12 new believers in our home church Apedokoe and 20 new believers at Korbongou our second church. The door was opened for our second church to start a new work at Oulongou II on the will of the chief of this village. Togolese people are hungry to hear the Gospel but there are few laborers. We need teachers to come down in Togo just for training young people called to preach. If you are reading this newsletter and God is dealing in your heart to do this, feel free to send me an email. I was so desperate to see many villages without a church. Our vision for Togo it is not only to plant churches but to help other Togolese pastors to increase their knowledge of the Bible through Bible College, Pastor Conferences etc. For this reason we hold every year Pastor Conference where Pastors from States come down to preach and to teach.

We thank God for our third annual Pastors Conference that was held on February 23 to 25 where 130 national pastors attended from everywhere in Togo and 5 national pastors from Burkina Faso. Brothers John Shelley, David Roth and Ray David from the States were there to preach and teach. The conference was a big success in spite the fear of Ebola. It was a blessing because souls were saved and more believers rededicated their life again to the Lord in revival time that was held in three different places in our country.

Let me thank churches and individuals that helped us to dig a well in our new place. May the Lord bless everyone that made this happened. Now we have water and we just wait for a health department to tell us it is OK to drink.

### Here a few request prayers I need that the Lord would provide quickly:

1. We need to dig a well for our home church at Apedokoe because the attendance is growing. People need water to use in bathroom and to drink. We need \$2,400 and church itself raised so far \$500.
2. The work of the Sunday school building was interrupted because we are running out of financial means. It is a huge challenge for us to complete the building because we still need \$8,715.75 to finish this project which will be used not only for Sunday school but for Christian School. Right now we have 2 classrooms, one office, one storage and four toilettes. We have more than 130 to 150 children in every Sunday and I believe that it would be good to open a Christian School for them.
3. Keep praying for us we are now in 4 years in mission field and we are praying if God will, to be in the States at the end of this year 2015 in order to give a report and present our projects to our brothers and sisters.
4. Right now we have a big need of motorcycle to go to remote village to preach the Gospel at OULONGOU II. If one church can take this need and ask God to provide the funds that will be a wonderful. It is only \$1,000.
5. Keep praying for my health and for my children, they are growing fast.

I would not finish without say special thanks for churches and individuals that sent sacrificial gifts this last year and also for those that continue to send encouraging cards to us.

May the Lord bless all for your faithful prayers.
