

Dear Pastor and Friends ,

These past two months were very busy for us. Every Thursday and Saturday were our evangelism days. We have fixed a wonderful goal to reach at least 1,500 people with Gospel in March and April. By the grace of God we made it:

In March 19th, we brought together 250 teenagers from Baptist churches in the city of Lome to take out the gospel for the whole day.

We divided 250 into 83 groups of 3 with goal to reach a least 10 people. For the one day we reached more than 800 people with the Gospel. The Holy Spirit touched some people that made a profession of faith. We had more than 50 people that made a profession of faith; some of these 50 visited our church the next Sunday.

We did not stop there, the afternoon of the last Sunday of March and April; all the members of True Light Baptist Church of Apedokoe with their children went out to knock on doors at Apedokoe, and at Kleme. It was fantastic to see a parent with their children present the good news to the people and the children gave out a tract to everyone they saw on the road.

The great commission is for every believer and we have to teach our people the way to do it. Since January I have been teaching my people the way to do "personal evangelism" and God is touching my people to take seriously this mission.

Luke 1:79 says, "To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace."

A lot of Togolese people are still in darkness and my mission is to go everywhere to preach in order that a people must be saved.

On March 25, the door opened for me to preach at Bread of Life Baptist Church of Kladjeme and two precious souls were saved.

Psalm 48: 14 says, "For this God is our God for ever and ever: he will be our guide even unto death."

Togolese people must know our wonderful God, the creator of heaven and the earth. Idols are not God, and we have to preach to it that people must know it.

True Light Baptist Church of Kleme, a temple of Victory is growing. God is working, the attendance is now: adult 16 children 20.

God is moving, one door is opened again for us to start a new work in the city of Tsevie, where there is no good sound preaching Baptist church. My half-brother donated land to start a church but I have no support to do it. God has already prepared the way for us; we have land in that city, a man, but no money. Keep praying for us.

Our Prayer requests:

My coming to the States, we are waiting for immigration service to grant our paper work.

Built a temple of True Light Baptist Church at Apedokoe our home church.

We are preparing to baptize 15 new believers.

A church will hold again its second wedding ceremony on August 5.

May the Lord bless all for your faithful prayers.
