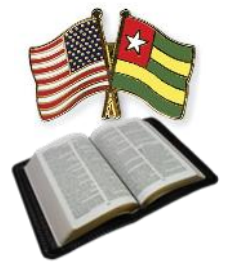

Before this happens we set up this criteria: a church must be self-supporting when this follows in place: a church building, self-supporting, and have a trained pastor in place.

Right now we do not have the church building, which is the big major challenger for us. I believe in a few more years this church would be able to pay its own pastor. Two brothers are in Bible School right to get training. May the Lord continue to bless you for the advance of His Kingdom in West Africa, especially in Togo and throughout the world.

We went through lots of problems, many challenges but the Lord was with us. No means of transportation for many months, and the financial struggles we are experiencing. All things were heavy on us but we kept our faith in Him. We continue to do door-door soul winning and the hand of God was upon our ministry. We have one rebellious person among us that had tried to raise the members of the church against my leadership. He failed in his "Satanic campaign" because the whole church was united behind me and we excommunicated him and the church was in peace.
