

Dear Pastor, church family, and praying Friends,

Since security has greatly improved, several activities have been organized. The most visible is the return of brothers and sisters to church in large numbers. Our focus in the beginning of this year to reach more villages with Gospel by open door evangelization. We have seen new believers walk miles to get to church. In some villages that have been evangelized, we have seen women and children walking more than 10 kilometers or even more to get to our church. To ease the burden on these women and children, we need two tricycles, one of which could cost us around \$2,500. Your help would be a great help in transporting these women and children. Right now, we are renting tricycles to bring these women and children to the church.



Evangelistic campaigns were organized, and many people came out to hear the good news. Souls were saved. In just one day, we saw 10 people saved.



We were able to enter areas traditionally hostile to Christians. Our brothers were able to present the gospel to Fulani people and offer gifts to war refugees.



Bibles were given to 5&6 grade students from our Christian School.



We continue to baptize the new believers from our daughter's mission churches.



God has opened many villages to plant churches, but there are no laborers. People are afraid to answer the call because of the many challenges missionaries are facing.

We are so thankful that God is faithful in every aspect of our life and our ministry. I want thank churches and brothers that send funds for building in Burkina Faso. We finally decided to start a real church building that was destroyed, not a Shelter, as God provided funds to do it.

Prayer Requests

.Keep praying for us that God will provide what we need to keep doing the ministries:

- Find more supporting churches
- Finish projects (buy land, we still need \$17,000 to reach our goal)
- Reach more villages with the gospel.
- Funds for transportation (we need a vehicle that can take us city to villages in remote areas) to preach the Gospel.

May the Lord bless more all our support churches, pastors, and friends.
